

PHYSICAL

Hitting, kicking, punching, spitting, tripping, pushing.



SOCIAL

Excluding someone, spreading rumors, making embarrassing comments.



VERBAL

Teasing, name calling, inappropriate sexual comments, or verbal or written threats.

COMMON TYPES OF

BULLYING

The proportion identifying themselves as bullies ranged from **3** to **20%**, with an average of **10 %**.



03

The share of children who identified themselves as victims ranged from **5** to **20%**, by country, with an average of **11%**.

According to a study including **25** countries, involvement in bullying varies widely across nations, ranging from nine to **54%**



Nearly **14%** of public schools report that bullying happens at least once a week.



Reports of bullying are highest for middle schools (**28%**) followed by high schools (**16%**),

Reports of bullying in combined schools are (**12%**), and primary schools (**9%**).

Reports of cyberbullying among public school attending students are

Highest for middle school (33%)



Followed by high school (30%)



Combined schools (20%)



Primary schools (5%)
