

The Child Protection System in Greece

Lack of national registry for reporting and recording abuse cases

Lack of central agency for the coordination of social service providers in abuse cases

Unclear legal frame of reference

Understaffed Social Service Agencies

Lack of training for professionals working with children

Lack of foster care system




- ❖School-based sexual abuse prevention program for children in grades K-3.


Providing assistance, psychological support and legal counseling




